

<p>2) Which attachment is applicable if the supply cable is fixed by the crimped or soldered connection?</p> 			
Decision			
<p>1) No, connection by crimping or soldering is not considered as non-replaceable. The final evaluation of the complete luminaire for compliance with clauses 4.29 and 4.30 needs to be done with the checks of clauses 4.29 and 4.30 accordingly.</p> <p>2) Y attachment is applicable, as crimped or soldered connection is not considered as breaking or destroying a luminaire.</p>
